- 6. It is expected that Beta Club members will treat WHS administration, teachers, staff, and other students with utmost respect.
- 7. Any suspensions are considered grounds for immediate dismissal from Beta Club.
- 8. Wakefield High School Administrations or the Beta advisor can remove any student for disciplinary actions at any time.
